Rochester Covered Bridge

West on 138 for 1.5 miles. Turn Right onto Stearns Lane a drive ½ mile, turn left onto Rochester Bridge Road. Built in 1933, Length 80 ft.

Hines Walnut Tree

12 miles northwest of Sutherlin, milepost 12.36 - next to the yellow creek bridge. A tree *not* native to Oregon located at a probable Indian camping and fishing ground, predates the arrival of settlers, Drive – by viewing only.

Wedding Chapel – is listed in the Stephens National Historic District, 2 ½ miles West of Sutherlin, off Ft. McKay Rd. built in 1906 by the Southern Episcopal Methodist Church.
